

Eleanor Harvey
(born John Birks Gillespie 1917 - 1993)

Eleanor Harvey was one of the founders of the Englewood Historical Society in 1976, which she vigorously led as its president until her death. She was largely responsible for the Liberty Square memorial at the Monument, the classical clock in front of City Hall, and the promotion of historical publications about Englewood. A teacher in the Englewood Public Schools for several decades, she devoted her later years to teaching us all about our local history, historic buildings, and the many notable people who have lived here.
